ARE YOU INTERESTED IN A CAREER HEALTHCARE?

Allied Healthcare Mentors are offering an amazing opportunites for virtual work experience, and if you are interested in becoming a medic in the following careers, then read on.

Nursing, Midwifery, Paramedicine, Physiotherapy, Occupational Therapy, Dietetics, Radiography, Prosthetics and Orthotics, Speech and language therapy and Pharmacy

Health Education England has recently completed a discovery report on virtual work experience programmes, which have concluded that these programmes are a valuable addition to in-person work experience, especially by preparing students for in-person placements and where in-person experiences are extremely limited.

The NHS Allied Healthcare Work Experience successfully invited 12,000 students to participate in the last academic year, making it the largest programme for students who are specifically interested in these careers.

Applications for this programme are now open, and they will be open throughout this academic year, with the next virtual work experience day taking place on the 5th November. If you are in Year 10, 11, or 13 and you are interested in the careers above, please consider participating in the monthly virtual work experience days.

During the work experience day, students will follow 2 patients from their initial presentation to recovery. Students will observe the healthcare professionals as you interact with the patients and each other. Students will have an opportunity to ask questions and gain knowledge through teaching.

This will help you to make an informed career decision as well as learn about how healthcare professionals work together as part of a multidisciplinary team. Each work experience day is completely different, and you will be able to build on your knowledge of NHS careers as you see different patient cases and healthcare professionals work in a variety of settings, such as hospital and community.

When completed, you will also receive certificates as evidence of having participated in the work experience programme. Those that complete the entire 6-month programme will be awarded with Highly Commended References too.

Students can register individually through the website link below. Places are £10 a day to cover administrative costs and run the tech on the day.










Mathematics Salaries by Region



ENGINEERING

Are you interested in how things work or are made?

You will learn to produce complex high value, low volume components or assemblies, using machines and hand tools. Fitters may typically have a mechanical, electrical, electronic, control systems or instrumentation bias.

An engineering fitter, often referred to simply as a "fitter," is a highly skilled tradesperson in the field of mechanical and electrical engineering and manufacturing. Fitters are responsible for assembling, installing, maintaining, and repairing machinery, equipment, and mechanical systems. Their role is crucial in ensuring that machinery and systems operate efficiently and safely.

Qualifications

You will work towards: Level 3 Engineering Fitter Apprenticeship Standard • EAL Level 3 Diploma in Advanced Manufacturing Engineering (Development Knowledge)

We require five GCSEs at Level 4 and above. This must include English and maths.

Key roles and tasks:

- Interpreting technical drawings and diagrams.
- Assembly and Installation of mechanical or electrical components and systems.
- Use of machinery and hand tools.
- Precision working to ensure everything fits together correctly.
- Metrology you may use measuring equipment.
- Documentation to record the
