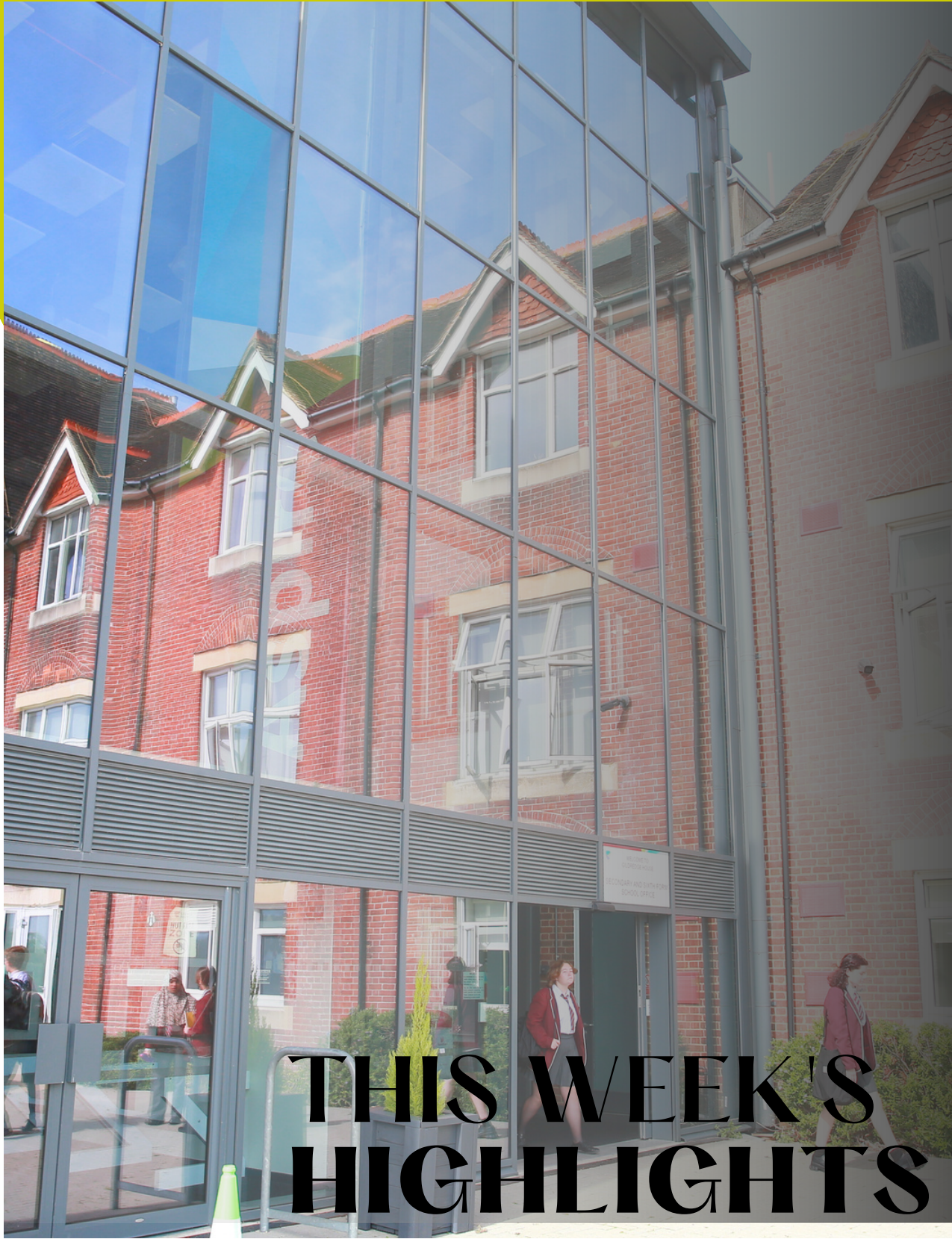


Careers > East Sussex

Year 13 Russell Group University Applications

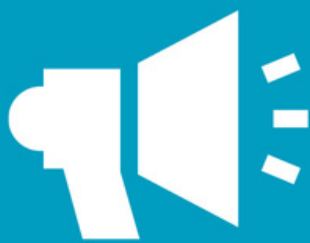
If you are interested in going to a Russell Group University? Make sure you don't miss their upcoming official Meet the Russell Group webinars.
