Attendance Policy

At Gildredge House we have an Attendance Policy available at the above link.

As we are now into the winter months and there is increased illness amongst children, we wanted to write and remind everyone of our attendance policy for you to follow, should your child be absent from school.

If your child is absent from school due to illness, please notify the school before 8.00am by using the 'Absence Reporting' link in the EduLink app, by sending an email to absences@gildredgehouse.org.uk or by telephoning 01323 400650. Please select option 2, 1, 1 for Primary absences and option 3, 1, 1 for Secondary or Sixth Form absences and remember to include your child's full name, Tutor Group / Class and reason for absence. Please notify the school on each day of absence. Please refer to the Student Attendance Policy for full details.

<u>Withdrawal from Learning</u>

We do expect all children to attend on a daily basis, but if a leave of absence is required due to exceptional circumstances, please complete a Request for Withdrawal from Learning Form a minimum of 14 days in advance of the day(s) concerned. Available here.

Medical Appointments

Should your child need to leave school during the course of the day for a medical appointment, the Attendance Team should be informed in advance, using the 'Absence Reporting' link in the EduLink app, by sending an email to absences@gildredgehouse.org.uk or by telephoning 01323 400650. Please select option 2, 1, 1 for Primary absences and option 3, 1, 1 for Secondary or Sixth Form absences and remember to state your child's full name, Tutor Group / Class and reason for absence. An appointment card must be provided as evidence of the appointment to the Primary School Office or Secondary and Sixth Form School Office. This can be attached using the 'paperclip' in the Absence Reporting link in the EduLink App or emailed to absences@gildredgehouse.org.uk. Students leaving school Defore the end of the school day should report to the Secondary and Sixth Form School Office to sign out.








Drop off & Parking Refresher

As the weather gets colder, more and more children are getting dropped off, please take a look at the Drop-off arrangements.



Parent Parking: Years R and 1 only
Staff Parking Only
Student Drop-off Point: Years 2-6

Use of Car Park and School Drive

All users must:

- 1. Follow road markings which are provided for everyone's safety.
- 2. Restrict speed to a maximum of 5mph.
- 3. Park carefully in designated spaces, avoiding double yellow lines or designated drop-off zones.

Parent Parking / Student Drop-off: Mornings Only

Parents of students in Reception and Year 1 should park in the parent parking area located round the perimeter of the car park. Please note: if you have children in multiple Year Groups including a child in Reception or Year 1, you may park in Reception and Year 1 area indicated on the map with red triangles. Please note Kiss & Drop Off is for Primary students only.

Parents of students in Year 2-6 should proceed to drive up the school driveway using the left-hand lane, observing the speed limit of 5mph and drop the student(s) at the top of the drive before reaching the zebra crossing, then follow the drive round to the right and proceed out of the school grounds, giving way to cars leaving the school car park.


End of Day Arrangements


FOGH CHRISTMAS JUMPER DAY



Experience Team from East Sussex also delivered presentation on around procedure gaining work experience pre-placement check (which surprisingly straight forward) and Matt Roach, from KPMG spoke about Environmental and Social Governance. This is a first event for a school in Eastbourne, and Gildredge House hopes to lead the way in continuing to create a forward looking careers programme.
