ESAFETY

We realise a lot of Gildredge House Students received new devices such as mobiles, laptops and tablets for Christmas.

These are fantastic tools when used correctly by students and can really make learning interactive. However as a school we know the risks that can come from such devices. At Gildredge House we take online safety seriously.

We understand students wanting to show friends any new mobiles and tablets they received; these will need to be turned off in school or handed to the Secondary School Office every day before Tutor period.

No student should be found with a mobile phone in the school day. These will be confiscated and will only be able to be collected from the secondary School Office at the end of the day.

This is to limit damage and possible damage to any students mobiles and also creates an environment that students can focus in and limits any disturbances.
