FREE SCHOOL MEALS

Infant Free School Meals

Your child gets free school meals if they are in:

- Reception class
- Year 1
- Year 2



If you get any of the benefits listed below, your child's school will get more funding. Apply online now if you're entitled. This will ensure your child gets free school meals as they move to Year 3.

Apply for free school meals online

Free school meals for children in Year 3 and older

Older children may get free school meals if their parents or carers get any of these benefits:

- <u>Universal Credit GOV.UK</u> if you apply on or after 1 April 2018 your household income must be less than £7,400 a year (after tax and not including any benefits you get)
- Income Support GOV.UK
- Income-based <u>Jobseeker's Allowance (JSA) GOV.UK</u>
- Income-related <u>Employment and Support Allowance (ESA) GOV.UK</u>
- Support under <u>Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999 GOV.UK</u>
- The Guaranteed element of <u>State Pension Credit -GOV.UK</u>
- <u>Child Tax Credit GOV.UK</u> only, if your annual household income isn't over £16,190 (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs)
- Working Tax Credit run-on, paid for 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit[Anyone who gets <u>Working Tax Credit - GOV.UK</u> won't get free meals regardless of income]

Children eligible for free school meals on or after 1 April 2018 will remain eligible until they finish the phase of schooling (primary or secondary) they are in on 31 March


The steering group will take part in two sessions that will take place in school on:


