Uniform Reminder


WOWWHAT AN OPEN EVENT

CONGRATULATIONS JOSHUA!!



Last weekend, Joshua competed in the National Windsurfing Championships at Grafham Water. Over the course of two days, Joshua completed in 9 races, coming 1st overall in one race and he also gained a 2nd and 3rd place. The wind on the second day challenged some of the experienced adults! Competing against 45 other U15 and U17 windsurfers, Joshua came 3rd overall and 2nd in his U17 fleet, despite being only 14. This is a remarkable achievement as Joshy has only been windsurfing for three years.

During the Summer holidays, Joshua represented Great Britain in Quiberon at the World Championships. This was an amazing experience and again he was competing against U17 boys from Greece, France, Spain and even Japan to name a few countries. He is hoping to be selected to represent Great Britain again next summer to compete in Hungary.

The shop will open again on Friday 19 Januar with further opening times planned for each month after that.


