Welcome

Welcome to the Gildredge House Twilight Activity Booklet for the Autumn Term 1 & 2 2023. These activities are for students in Years 3-6 only.

Gildredge House Twilight Activities are optional and will be on a first-come, first-served basis. **Students in Years 3-6 may participate in a maximum of two Twilight Activities a week.** Once your child has decided which of the following activities they wish to sign up to, please book and pay via their sQuid account. Please note that payments, once made, are non-refundable.

Gildredge House Twilight Activities are booked and paid for on a termly basis. Once your payment is received, your child will be deemed to have opted into the selected Twilight Activities.

- **Wednesday 12th July 2023 at 8.00pm: Bookings open.**
- **Thursday 31st August 2023 at midnight: Bookings close. After this date, no further bookings can be secured and no exceptions will be made.**
- **Monday 11th September 2023: Twilight Activities commence.**
- **Thursday 7th December 2023: Twilight Activities finish.**

Please note: Primary Twilight Activities will not be taking place on the week when a Primary Parents' Evening is scheduled, ie week commencing 9th October 2023.

Parent Declaration

1.
